- Redistricting Rules and Goals

Federal Laws: Equal Population, Federal Voting Rights Act, No Racial Gerrymandering

Traditional Redistricting Principles: Communities of interest, Compact, Contiguous, Visible (Natural & man-made) boundaries, Respect voters' choices/continuity in office, Planned future growth

Dr. Levitt shared the following four (4) maps:

- Green Map: Deviation - 6.1%

Follows freeways and major roads, dividing the rural areas between 1, 3 and 4

- Orange Map: Deviation - 8.9%

Compact map, particularly in the central part of the City of Greenfield

- Purple Map: Deviation - 8.2%

Each area has a district facility

- Yellow Map: Deviation - 2.3%

Each area has a school, each area has some farming/rural population

Following the presentation the Board discussed each of the maps and Board members were in agreement that the Yellow Map was the best choice of the four maps presented.
