Dear GUSD Parents, Families, and Community,

I hope this weekly communication finds you all doing well and ready to continue great learning experiences in 2021! I know our GUSD staff family has been extremely excited to welcome back our children/youth and to see them back in our virtual classrooms. We continue to wish you all things wonderful in good health and wellness.

As we return from the holidays, many of our school spaces will be open M-W with our school offices being staffed with limited personnel to do our part in slowing the spread of COVID. Our Family Resource center will remain open Mondays through Wednesdays until further notice as well. Please know that we sincerely care for you and continue to urge you to stay at home, wear a mask, wash your hands, and physically distance from others when outside your home. We thank you for your cooperation as we await our turn for the vaccine to be available and dispersed to our GUSD community.

Monterey County/Bay Area region is well below the 15% ICU capacity (**currently at 4.7%**). We will continue to follow all directives provided by the [CDPH Guidance](#) and [existing state guidance regarding PreK-12 schools](#), so we can continue to operate our GUSD programs safely as our collective **mission is to care for and protect the GUSD family!**

Greenfield Positive COVID Cases: As of January 15, 2021, there are 34,482 positive cases in Monterey County, 10,644 in South County, and 2,246 in Greenfield with 1,062 of those in Greenfield that have already recovered. Please see this [flyer](#) to make a testing appointment if you feel ill. Everyone must wear a mask to help stop the spread of COVID. Monterey County Vaccine Distribution: As of January 14, 2021, the MCHD shared news that the COVID vaccine has arrived and is being dispensed to all agencies per the Tiered phases identified by the Governor of California. Those in the medical industry, first responders, and the elderly have already begun receiving their vaccine with now our school agencies awaiting their turn to be vaccinated. GUSD has submitted our request to MCHD to have all our education personnel who voluntarily decide to be vaccinated accounted for. We look forward to it!

Governor Newsom's COVID Cases Color-coded County News: The Governor continues to utilize a color-coding system to monitor California and to determine when schools might be eligible for in-person instruction. California is experiencing a definite surge with **54/58 counties with elevated COVID cases** and statewide ICU capacity at 3.0% as of today. Please visit [this web link](#) for info.

Out of State Travel News: The Governor's Executive Order has placed a temporary hold on out-of-state travel and is asking families to **NOT travel** as the number of positive cases are sky-rocketing in California and overwhelming our hospital and medical industry. **GUSD humbly asks you to do the same.** Please halt all unnecessary travel plans during the school year so that you and others in your care can remain safe and healthy.
